Year 11	Maths x2 English x2 Science x2 Option A Option B Option C Option D	10 x 1 hour = 10 hours



Homework Timetable - Key Stage 5

Year/Pathway	Subject	Recommended minimum hours per week
Year 12 A Level	While studying 4 A levels each students will get 4 hours homework and reading around the subject. When students drop to 3 A levels this should increase to 5 hours	4x4 hours = 16 hours January onwards - 3x5 hours = 15 hours
Year 12 BTEC	Students should be completing 15 hours of individual study to ensure that they complete the course for the Extended Diploma.	Extended Diploma = 15 hours
Year 13 A Level	For each A level students should be doing 5 hours of homework and reading around the subject	3 x 5 hour = 15 hours
Year 13 BTEC	Students should be completing 15 hours of individual study to ensure that they complete the course for the Extended Diploma.	Extended Diploma = 15 hours
