Dear Parent/Carers of students in Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 12,

We are delighted to be supporting the Green for Grenfell remembrance day this Friday 15th June. Students in Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 12 are invited to wear green to school for the day. Any student who chooses not to wear green must wear their school uniform. A suggested donation of £1 will be collected as students arrive in the morning and we ask that the correct change is brought to ease collection. The Academy will be operating as normal on this day and all students are expected to be on time, prepared for all their lessons and adhere to the usual high expectations expected of them.

We have stressed to our students that the 'green' clothing worn must be suitable for school and we request that you support this by checking the outfit that your son/daughter chooses to wear. Students who are inappropriately dressed will be asked to go home and change and we would of course prefer to avoid any interruptions to learning. Tutors will be discussing the importance of this community event in Tutor times this week.

Unacceptable green clothing:

For health and safety reasons no additional jewellery may be worn than is acceptable on a normal school day

Stiletto, high or pointed heels, platform shoes

Low cut or otherwise revealing tops

Short or otherwise revealing skirts or trousers

Hats are not permitted
