Non-Uniform Day – Friday 15th March 2019

We are delighted to be supporting the charity 'Comic Relief' by holding a non-uniform day on Friday 15th March. Our STARs (Student Leadership Team) suggested that this day should be an opportunity for students to be proactive in raising money for much needed causes.

Students are invited to bring a suggested donation of £2 in return for wearing their own **red themed clothing** to school. Donations will be collected as students arrive in the morning. We ask that the correct change is brought to ease collection. The Academy will be operating as normal and all students are expected to be on time and prepared for all their lessons on this day and adhere to the usual high expectations expected of them. Lanyards must be worn by all students in line with Safeguarding procedures.

We have stressed to our students that the clothing worn as 'non-uniform' must be suitable for school and we request that you support this by checking the outfit that your child chooses to wear. Students who are inappropriately dressed will be asked to go home and change and we would of course prefer to avoid any interruptions to learning.

Unacceptable clothing for non-uniform days:

- High or pointed heels, platform shoes
- Low cut or otherwise revealing tops including crop tops
- Short or otherwise revealing skirts or trousers
- Hats and coats are not permitted inside the school building
- No additional jewellery or make up may be worn than is acceptable on a normal school day.

Funds collected will be split equally between 'Comic Relief' and the 'National Autistic Society' which among many other services provides specialist autism support to schools and invaluable support groups within local communities, which benefit children with autism and their parents.
