Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of the Metropolitan Police prevention response to recent knife crime in the wider community, we work closely with our Safer Schools Officer PC Gaster to accommodate the use of knife wandng at The Harefield Academy periodically throughout the academic year.

Naturally the school fully supports the Metropolitan Police in preventing knife crime and we have always educated our students about the importance of not carrying weapons and the potential impact it can have on their future.

As part of a joint partnership with our local school liaison officer PC Gaster it remains our priority to ensure that we safeguard our students and staff on their journey to and from school and whilst within the school grounds.

Please be assured that knife wandng checks are not triggered as a reaction to a particular incident but are common practice in secondary schools as a safeguarding procedure and preventative measure recommended by the met police. Any such wandng activities that take place during a period of COVID-19 related restrictions, would adhere closely to the control measures put in place by The Academy and Safer Schools Officer to minimise risk of infection.

Students and parents/carers will not be informed of what day(s) knife wandng is to be used.

Any student carrying a knife or illegal weapons would be arrested for doing so, and as per the Ladder of Consequence may face permanent exclusion from The Academy. Please be advised that as well as illegal items we will confiscate any contraband, or prohibited items that a student is found in possession of.

If the school had not consented to knife wandng, the police would carry out the process outside the school. I am sure you will agree that this procedure is best carried out within the privacy of the school and with the support of senior staff.
